

Tang Fishing Gear Suggestions

- 2 - 3 Fishing Poles with Spinning Reels (Bait Casting Reels)
- Tackle Box & Stringers
- Filet Knife
- "Walleye / Bass" Pole with 6 - 8 lb. Test
- "Northern / Lake Trout" Pole with 10 - 12 lb. Test
- 7 Day Fishing License (about \$24 - \$48 U.S. depending on license type)

Tackle Suggestions

Walleye

- Jig and Minnow (Leech & Night Crawler)
- Lindy Rigs (Floating & Non-Floating Jigs)
- Spinners
- Floating Rapala's or Frenzy lure

Northern

- Daredevils
- Cleo's
- Any Casting Spoon
- Rapalas

Lake Trout

- 4' - 5' "Deep Diving" Rapalas
- 4' - 5' Rapala DT-10 & DT-16
 - ✓ Black & Silver DT-10 & 16 for sure in your arsenal
 - ✓ Variety of colors
- Any Rapala - the bigger, the better
- "Shallow Diving" & "Deep Diving" (every day is different)
- "Flat Fish" Lure
- "Rattle Trap" Lure
- 3"-4" Tube Jigs (white)

Large and Small Mouth Bass

- Most of the above will also catch Bass
- Plastic Worms
- Spinner Baits
- "Bass" Lures

Live Bait

For the days you plan to fish walleye, plan on using about 2 dozen per person, per day, of the live bait that you prefer (i.e. 4 guys x 2 dozen/day x 2 days equals about 16 dozen minnows, leeches and/or worms needed). This calculation works quite well for estimating how much live bait to purchase before you fly in.
